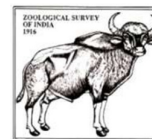

In such a case the progress of Research Fellow would be assessed each year by an Assessment Committee. Extension of fellowship will be considered based on Committee's report, together with the detailed progress report duly supported by reprints/preprints/manuscript of the papers published, accepted or communicated and duly approved by the Competent Authority. The total tenure of PDF is 5 years.

Conditions for the Award: The acceptance of Fellowship should be communicated by the Candidate to the Principal Investigator, LTEO Programme, Zoological Survey of India within fifteen days of the issue of offer letter of award of the Fellowship. A candidate called for interview will be paid Second Class Railway fares by the shortest route from his/her place of permanent residence to the place of interview and back. If a place is connected by rail as well by road or partly by road and partly by rail, the candidate will be entitled to one Second Class Railway fare and or lower class bus fare, whichever is less.

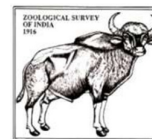
